PURPOSE OF THE R	FOLIEST					

To whom it may concern,

We have been looking into the bronze+ categorisation which we understand is in place to level the playing field for teams consisting of a fast bronze driver alongside a silver driver to prevent an unfair advantage whereby a team is, in effect, 2 silver-speed drivers. However, this is not the case for us and as such I submit this form to request clarity and consideration for our circumstances.

Our team (Team Thor) consists of a very inexperienced bronze driver (Audunn Gudmundsson) and an experienced bronze driver (Thomas Ashton – myself). As such, if I, as the experienced bronze driver, achieve silver-level pace on occasion, that would mean we only equal (not exceed) a standard silver/bronze pairing. If we then incur the additional Bronze+ penalty, I cannot see a situation where we would not finish in last place due to the severe time penalties imposed.

For example, if I was graded Bronze+, our overall race time would be 20-120 seconds more than if I was silver graded. This makes sense if a bronze+ driver is paired with a silver driver to level the playing field, however, in our case we are a (potential) bronze+ paired with another slower, bronze, gentleman driver. This already puts us on a level playing field with a bronze/silver pairing, so any penalty would only be penalising us further.





Therefore, I ask if this bronze+ rule will also apply to a bronze/bronze pairing such as ours. As the only bronze/bronze team in the series, this would be very prohibitive for us. I would like to ask if this rule could be reviewed or waived for bronze/bronze pairings in light of this. As bronze/bronze, we do not stand to have an unfair advantage in the championship even if I were to perform well, unlike teams with a silver and fast-bronze pairing, and therefore any penalty would be very punishing.

Many thanks in advance for your consideration of this matter, I look forward to hearing from you and hope that there may be a way to resolve this.
