The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

N° / Driver: 70 / Oscar Tunjo
Competitor: GEBHARDT MOTORSPORT
Session: Race
Time (fact): 18:59
Fact: Car 70 (Tunjo) made contact with Car 65 (Neumann) at Turn 4
Offence: Breach of Appendix L Chapter IV Article 2 d of International Sporting Code
Decision: 10 second time penalty. In addition, 1 point deducted (balance of 7 for the 2025 season).
Reason: The Stewards reviewed CCTV video evidence which showed that Car 70 was overtaking another car approaching Turn 4 on the left side of the track. Car 65 was already entering the corner, having been partly on the exit kerb from the previous corner. Car 70 also attempted to overtake Car 65 but failed to leave at least one full car width for Car 65 to rejoin the track, making contact with Car 65. The Stewards determined that Car 70 was predominantly responsible for the collision.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
