





Appendix L ISC Chapter IV Art. 2.c)

Drivers must use the track at all times and may not leave the track without a justifiable reason. For the avoidance of doubt, the white lines defining the track edges are considered to be part of the track but the kerbs are not.














RED FLAG - PRACTICE SESSIONS

- → All cars must reduce the speed to 80 Kph & head to the pit lane






DOUBLE YELLOW FLAGS





 - Category winners (LMP3, LMP3 ProAm, GT3) enter the pit lane and park under the podium.
 - Cars to Scrutineering enter the pit lane and drive to directly to pit exit and then to scrutineering
 - All other cars (Parc Fermé) cross the Line a second time and stop on track after the Start Line


QUALIFYING - PIT LANE MOVEMENTS

- Before each session: access to fast lane on RC instructions. (Standby on Chequered flag from previous session)
- End of each single Session (GT3 // LMP3 PRO-AM // LMP3): all cars to drive directly to Paddock / Scrutineering
- All trolleys to remain in the pit lane until the end of LMP3 Qualifying Session
- No trolleys movements before RC instructions



PIT LANE

THE CAR CONTROLLER (LOLLIPOP MAN) IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONTROL OF THE PIT STOP & ITS SAFETY NOT ALLOWED TO DO ANY OTHER OPERATION.



- NO Parking with a 45° angle accepted.
- QUALIFYING access to fast lane on RC instructions.
- End of sessions
