**Fact:** Car #53 did not fulfill the initial scrutineering requirements identification stickers on.

Offence: Breach of Article 4.1.5 of RTLM Sporting Regulations

**Decision:** The Competitor's car must be rechecked by the technical scrutineers before taking part in any

session of the event.

**Reason:** The technical delegate reported to the Stewards that the car was presented without identification

stickers, which are mandatory to be allowed to take part in any session of the competition. The competitor must therefore be rechecked by the technical scrutineers before taking part in any

session of the event.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
