The Stewards, having received a report from the RTLM Race Director and having considered the following matter, determine that a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Competitor: ANS MOTORSPORT
Session: Free Practice 2

Time (fact): 20:47:32

Fact: The car #6 and car #7 were involved in a collision at MP35.

Offence: Article 2 d) Chapter IV Appendix L of International Sporting Code

Decision: No further action.

Reason: The Stewards summoned and heard from both competitors and drivers. All present viewed circuit

CCTV footage of the incident.

The driver of car#6 stated that he had difficulty seeing the track clearly due to the setting sun and also missed the apex of the corner. Having previously overtaken car#7 he did not anticipate or see car#7 approaching the corner at a faster speed. Car#7, having gained on car#6 was also affected by the sunlight and did not consider that car#6 might also be affected and unable to see clearly.

The Stewards determine that both drivers could have anticipated the incident and should be more

careful in the future under similar circumstances.

The Stewards consider that neither driver was wholly or predominantly responsible and therefore

take non further action.

The Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with the Art.15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
