The Stewards, having received a report from the Timekeepers, have considered the following:

N° / Driver: 49 / Mark PATTERSON
Competitor: HIGH CLASS RACING

Session: Race 1 Time (fact): 18:58

Fact: The Timekeepers reported that the first driver failed to achieve the minimum driver stint time by 7

seconds.

Offence: Breach of Article 13.2.3 of RTLM Sporting Regulations

Decision: Stop and Go penalty of 7 seconds to be served. This is converted to a post race total time penalty

of 47 seconds to be added to the overall race time (comprising the Stop & Go penalty of 40

seconds and the 7 seconds to be served).

Reason: The Stewards, summoned and heard the Team Manager, examined timekeeping evidence. The

Stewards determined that the first driver failed to achieve the 25 minutes stint time due to the car

entering the pits 7 seconds too early.

The Stewards determine that the above penalty be imposed in accordance with the Article 13.2.5

of the RTLM Sporting Regulations.

The Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Art.15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
