The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, heard from the Competitors' Representative and the Driver concerned, (Summons 17 & 18) have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Competitor: P4 RACING

Fact: Car 27 (Ferguson) made contact with Car 95 (Broggi) at Turn 1.
Offence: Breach of Appendix L Chapter IV Article 2 d of the FIA of International Sporting Code
Decision: Warning given to the Driver of Car 27.
Reason: The Stewards summoned and heard the drivers and team representatives and together they examined circuit cctv and onboard video from both cars.

Car 95 slowed at Turn 18 to allow Car 27 to pass. Approaching Turn 1, Car 27 slowed earlier than previously, whilst Car 95, intending to start a fast lap, thought that Car 27 had slowed to allow Car 95 to pass.

Car 95 was fully alongside Car 27 when they made contact at Turn 1. The Driver of Car 95 stated that he thought that Car 27 was previously on a fast lap, which is why he let him by at Turn 18. Then the Driver of Car 95 wanted to start a fast lap and that that Car 27 was slowing to enter the pits.

The Driver of Car 27 drove passed Car 95 but then significantly slowed approaching Turn 1 and did not appreciate that Car 95 was approaching at greater speed.

The Stewards determined that both drivers made an error of judgement, however the Driver of Car 27 was predominantly responsible through his action of slowing and turning later for Turn 1.


