The Stewards, having received a report from the RTL M Race Director, having examined video evidence and having considered the following matter, determine that no breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose no penalty.

Competitor: TEAM WRT

Session: Race

Time (fact): 10:43:33

Fact: Car 72 cut the chicane between MP11 and MP12 and allegedly gained an advantage.

Offence: Alleged Breach of Appendix L Chapter IV Article 2c) of the FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision: No further action.

Reason: Car 14 and Car 72 were side-by-side approaching the braking zone for Turn 10 (the chicane between MP11 and MP12).

Due to an incident involving cars ahead, the driver of Car 72 elected to use the escape road in order to avoid a potential collision. At the same time, Car 14 remained on the track and was required to take avoiding action as a consequence of the incident ahead.

As a result, the relative positions and time loss of the two cars were affected by circumstances unrelated to the use of the escape road by Car 72.

Having reviewed the available video evidence, the Stewards are unable to determine with sufficient certainty that Car 72 gained a lasting advantage by leaving the track. In the circumstances, the benefit of the doubt is given to the driver of Car 72.

Accordingly, no further action is taken.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
