The Stewards, having received a report from the RTL M Race Director, consulted the Driver Advisor, having checked the video evidence, have considered the following matter

Fact: Cars 51, 45 and 95 were involved in an incident at Turn 2-3 at the Race Start.

Offence: Alleged breach of Appendix L Chapter IV, Article 2d) of FIA International Sporting Code

Decision: No further action.

Reason: The Stewards reviewed the available video evidence relating to the incident involving Cars 51, 45 and 95 at Turn 2-3 on the opening lap.

Having examined the footage, the Stewards determined that Cars 51 and 95 lost control and spun independently. The Stewards further determined that no contact occurred between Cars 51, 45 and 95.

As no driver was responsible for causing a collision and the available evidence does not establish a breach of Appendix L, Chapter IV, Article 2 d) of the FIA International Sporting Code, the Stewards determine that no offence has been committed.

Accordingly, no further action is taken.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
