## Decision no. 63

**From:** The Stewards **Date:** 12 June 2026  
**To:** INTER EUROPOL COMPETITION **Time:** 20:26

The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, heard from the Competitor's Representative, (Summons 16) have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

**N° / Competitor:** 34 / INTER EUROPOL COMPETITION  
**Session:** Race  
**Time (fact):** 13:05:33  
**Fact:** After receiving the checkered flag, Car 34 slowed at the exit of T3 and was then unable to proceed under its own power.  
**Offence:** Breach of Article 15.1.3 of RTLM Supplementary Regulations  
**Decision:** Disqualification of Car 34 from the Classification of the Race.

**Reason:** All cars originally classified behind Car 34 are moved up one place in the Race classification.  
The driver of Car 34, having taken the chequered flag, continued the lap before slowing down and stopping the car at the exit of T3, unable to continue under its own power.  
Marshals went to the assistance of the car and its driver. The driver seemed fit as he exited the car, and proceeded to follow Marshals' orders.  
The car was then pushed onto a recovery vehicle by the marshals and taken back to the parc fermé, as such not reaching the parc fermé under its own power. Considering previous similar cases, the Stewards elect to take the same penalty as was applied in the past.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
