The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

N° / Competitor: 87 / CLX MOTORSPORT
Session: Free Practice 2
Time (fact): 15:36
Fact: Car 87 was released into the path of another car which was already in the Fast Lane.
Offence: Breach of Article 12.1.2 of MLMC Sporting Regulations
Decision: A fine of 750 Euros to be paid by the Competitor. In accordance with Article 12.8.1 of the ISC, fines shall be paid within forty-eight hours of their notification by means of bank transfer to LMEM, in accordance with Article 7.2.5 of the Sporting Regulations.
Reason: The Stewards summoned and heard the driver and team representative (document 47) and together they examined video evidence. Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that the team was practising their timed pitstops, and the car controller gave the signal (thumbs up) that the fast lane was clear but did not anticipate that the car could not directly speed-up in the release action as the sister car of the team was just in front. Due to this slower movement, the car was released by the team directly into the path of another car in the fast lane. Both cars took avoiding actions and did not collide. We judge the team of car 87 fully responsible for this unsafe release.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
