The Stewards, having received a report from the Category Manager and having heard from the Competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

N° / Competitor: 7 / Nielsen Racing
Session: Before Event
Time (fact): 12:00 (07/09/2026)
Fact: The competitor has withdrawn Car 7 from the Silverstone event.
Offence: Breach of Article 3.1.2 of 2026 MLMC Sporting Regulations
Decision: A fine of 5000 Euros is to be paid by the Team for the withdrawal from the Silverstone event.
Reason: The promoter has received a formal communication from the competitor, notifying that the competitor cannot participate in the Silverstone event. The Stewards summoned and heard the team representative (document 4). The Stewards, having examined the details provided by the competitor and discussed the matter with them, determine that the above stated penalty be applied.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.

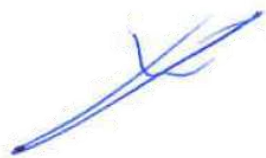

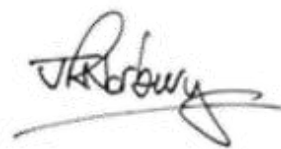
