The Stewards, having received a report from the Technical Delegate (Report n°3), having heard the Competitor, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

N° / Competitor: 71 / RINALDI RACING
Session: Free Practice 1
Time (fact): 11:54
Fact: Car 71 used four undeclared tyres during FP1.
Offence: Breach of Article 6.5.1 of MLMC Sporting Regulations
Decision: Fine of 1000€ per undeclared tyre; for a total of 4000€ for the 4 tyres (four thousand euros) as specified in Article 6.5.6 of the Sporting Regulations, to be paid by the Competitor.
Reason: The Stewards heard the team representative. During the Free Practice 1, the competitor used 4 carry-over tyres that were not declared on the list provided by the tyre manufacturer for the event. The Competitor recognized that the team did it unintentionally and apologized for the mistake. The Stewards determine that the Competitor is wholly responsible and elect to apply the standard penalty.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable timelimits.

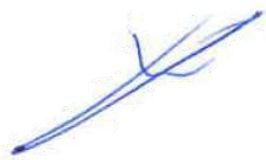
The fine has to be paid to the LMEM 48 hours as from the present notification:
