The Stewards, having received a report from the MLMC Race Director, having checked video evidence and heard the Team representative determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to

Fact: Not following Race Director's instructions at the end of the session
Offence: Breach of article 12.2.1 i) of International Sporting Code
Decision: Fine of 750 euros to be paid by the team
Reason: Chequered Flag was presented at 16:05:00, at 16:05:50 it is noticed that car 51 stopped in the working lane at the team's pit allocation and stopped for around 15secs, no mechanics worked on the car. The Race Director on a previous session and on multiple occasions at the end of this session instructed teams that they have to go directly to the paddock due to the constrained timing.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.

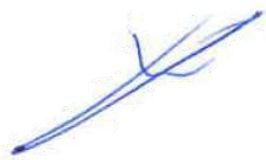
