The Stewards, having received a report from the MLMC Race Director, having checked video evidence and heard from both drivers determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Fact: Contact between cars 48 and 27 at T16
Offence: Appendix L Chap. IV, art 2d) of International Sporting Code
Decision: 5 minutes stop and go penalty to be served in Free Practice at the next event in which the Driver participates.

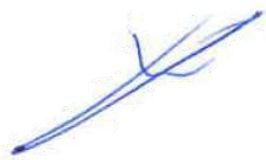
In addition, 1 point deducted (balance of 6 points for 2026 season).

Reason: Going towards T16 car 48 was some distance behind car 27. At the braking zone of T16 car 48 starts an overtake manoeuvre on the inside of car 27, car 48 is observed carrying too much speed in this manoeuvre and goes wide making side contact with car 27.

During the hearing the driver of car 48 stated he was surprised by the speed difference in the braking zone of car 27, and as such had to suddenly also decrease the approach speed towards this corner. At the same time the stewards note that on the onboard footage of car 48 the distance between car 27 and the car ahead in this approach remained constant.

The Stewards judge car 48 wholly responsible for this contact.

Competitors are reminded that, in accordance with Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 7.4.3 of the 2026 MLMC Sporting Regulations, this decision is not subject to appeal.
