The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director and having checked the video evidence, have considered the following matter

N° / Driver: 49 / Michael HOVE
Competitor: HIGH CLASS RACING
Session: Race
Time (fact): 17:15
Fact: Contact between cars 49 and 77 at T4.
Offence: Breach of Appendix L Chap. IV, art 2d) of FIA International Sporting Code
Decision: No further action.
Reason: Car 49 is observed going slow and wide at the entry of T3. At the exit of T3 car 49 runs over a slippery part of the track and spins into rear of car 77 making small contact. Car 77 continues but car 49 suffers damage and has to pit to repair damage. The stewards judge car 49 wholly responsible for this contact but taking into account that car 77 could continue and car 49 had to pit to repair damage decide that no further action is more appropriate on this occasion.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
